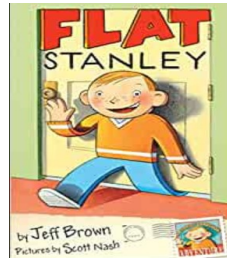
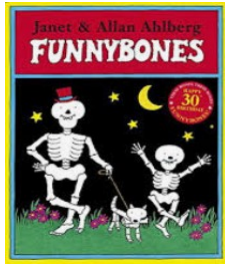

Handwriting: Pencil control and letter formation.



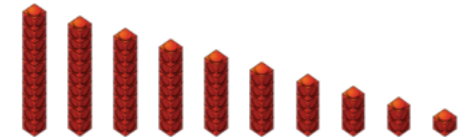

- Compare numbers correctly using the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.

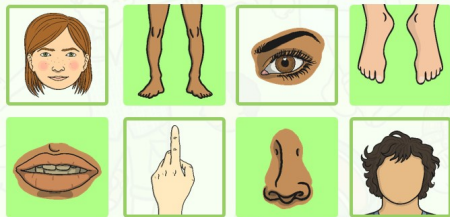


Science
